INTRO TO AWANA KOREA SOF TRAINING CENTER

Through a cooperative academic arrangement, Awana Korea and Bob Jones University are partnering to provide recent high school graduates from the network of Awana-affiliated churches in South Korea with a gap year experience that includes both challenging academics and practical ministry experience. Housed in the Awana Training Center in Seoul, South Korea, the program combines academic coursework, practical Biblical training, authentic ministry opportunities, English language development, and cultural engagement activities. The classes will be a combination of on-site teaching by BJU professors and online coursework through CANVAS.

STAFF NEEDS

- Discipleship Opportunities: You will participate in mentoring and discipling Korean students.
- Educational Travel: You will visit sites of cultural and historic importance in Korea.
- Language Learning: You will have informal opportunities to learn the Korean language.
- Personal Evangelism: You will engage in English-speaking ministry and evangelism opportunities.

Academic Coordinator (1 position available) (Graduate Student)

- Coordinate learning services
- Ensure the integrity of program assessments
- Maintain accuracy and confidentiality of academic records
- Provide leadership to and support of program assistants
- Participate in organized ministry activities
- Regularly communicate program updates with BJU primary contact

Program Assistant (2 positions available) (Undergraduate upperclassmen)

- Prioritize mentoring/discipleship of students
- Provide students with cultural assistance and learning support
- Participate in ministry activities
